FEICA publishes Safe Use of Mixtures Information (SUMI) for end-users

Communication throughout the supply chain is at the core of REACH. Safety data sheets are the main means to achieve this. Safe Use of Mixtures Information (SUMI) templates are a new arrival that provide simplified and tailored information.

FEICA has published a series of SUMIs for **professional end-users** of adhesives and sealants. SUMIs are one of the tools companies can use to communicate safety advice downstream to customers and end-users.

With these new publications, FEICA has contributed another element of the overall Use Map package within the [Chemical Safety Report/Exposure Scenario roadmap](#) – developed jointly with ECHA, Member States and other industry stakeholders - to improve the safe use of chemicals.

A SUMI is a communication template, developed by the Downstream Users of Chemicals Co-ordination Group (DUCC), of which FEICA is a member, to facilitate the information flow downstream to the end-users, i.e. professional and industrial workers.
